Injuries and Illnesses




Survey of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses

- Bureau of Labor Statistics
 - Quality, Metrics and Statistics Division
- Survey results are used to estimate the number of work-related injuries and illnesses and measure the frequency at which they occur
- Sample represents nearly every industry in Indiana/nationwide
- Results are reported one-year behind
- 2024 survey is currently in progress





2023 SOII Results




Census of Fatal Occupational Injuries

- Bureau of Labor Statistics
 - Quality, Metrics and Statistics Division
- Includes work-related fatalities resulting from unintentional and intentional injuries
- Multiple data sources
 - Death certificates
 - Coroners' reports
 - Police reports
 - News reports
 - Obituaries
 - Online memorials

New State Emphasis Program



What is a State Emphasis Program?

- Enforcement strategies designed and implemented at the regional state, or area office levels
- Intended to address hazards or industries that pose a particular risk to workers in the office's jurisdiction
- accompanied by outreach to raise awareness of the program and the noted hazards
 - Informational mailings
 - Training at local tradeshows
 - Speeches at meetings of industry groups or labor organizations

High Hazard Manufacturing

- Based on Survey of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses (SOII) data
- Identifies specific sub-industries in manufacturing with high injury and illness rates
 - North American Industry Classification System (NAICS)
- Targets these industries for increased enforcement and outreach action

| 3361 | Motor Vehicle Manufacturing | 6.4 |
| 3219 | Other Wood Product Manufacturing | 5.1 |

| 3212 | Veneer, Plywood, and Engineered Wood Product Manufacturing | 4.7 |

All About INSafe



What is INSafe?

- Education and outreach arm of OSHA
- Section 21(c) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (the OSH Act)
- On-site consultation can be provided <u>without</u> triggering the enforcement mechanisms of the OSH Act.



INSafe Consultations

- Onsite
 - INSafe Consultant visits your worksite
 - Comprehensive
 - Full safety
 - Full health
 - Limited scope
- Confidential
 - Employer/employee information is not shared with IOSHA enforcement
- Free!



Benefits of an INSafe Consultation

- Fresh set of eyes
- Dedicated safety and health professionals
- Free Hygiene Sampling
 - Mold
 - Silica
 - Hexavalent Chromium
 - Lead
 - Noise
- Assistance with S&H programs



Benefits of an INSafe Consultation

- Exclusion from most IOSHA Programmed Inspections
 - While consultation is underway
 - Opening conference through hazard correction
 - Does not include:
 - Imminent danger inspections
 - Fatalities
 - Complaints
 - Referrals

How We Work Alongside IOSHA

- Looking for similar hazards
- Experienced consultants
 - Many consultants were CSHOs
- Referrals from IOSHA Enforcement
 - Settlement agreements
 - Word-of-mouth
- Referrals to IOSHA
 - Refusal to correct (abate) serious hazards
 - Imminent danger


